The organization during the year of 2014-15 has been operated different programmed with various types of awareness activities and programmes under the Society Act. XXI of 1860.

5. To organize various games & sports, cultural and literacy competitions in the area amongst the locality and thereby try to encourage then in these fields.
6. To extent helping hand to the desirous and needy poor students for their upliftment as much as possible.
7. To undertake various social welfares works with the help of students of the area with a view to keeping the area neat, clean and pollution free one.
8. Providing economical assistant for the members, for there better economic development.
9. To help people of Assam by offering training programmes on Handicraft, Agriculture, Livestock Farming,

Fishery etc.

10. To develop awareness among the people of Assam to protect wild life and thereby maintain a balance between development and nature.

11. To develop social forestry due to present pollution and de-forestation problems.

12. To support flood/ cyclone and other natural calamities that affect both human population and the wild life of the state.

13. To make the area pollution free by undertaking tree plantation and other pollution control measures from time to time.

14. To organize free medical camps for the people living below poverty line in the remote villages where medical facilities are not easily available.

- Participatory Rural Appraisal is a methodology for interacting with villagers/community, understanding them and learning from them.
- It shifts the initiative from outsider to villager.
- PRA seeks to empower. It empowers the weak, the powerless and the marginalised, by enabling them to analyse, discuss and deliberate on their condition.
- Believes in flexibility in choosing methods.
- Reversal of learning.

Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) is an approach used by ITSS (NGOs) and Sponsored by SIRD (Skill Development Training Centers) involved 90 nos. people in community development. The approach aims to incorporate the knowledge and opinions of rural people in the planning and management of development projects and programs. This tool is also used for data collection. Besides it's an eclectic situational style (the humble, learning outsider) than a method. ITSS provide the participatory techniques aim to 'break the silence' of the poor and disadvantaged sections, recognize the value of popular collective knowledge and wisdom and legitimize the production of knowledge by the people themselves.
